

# Privacy policy

This privacy policy applies between you, the User of this Website and Marine Engineering Looe Ltd, the owner and provider of this Website. Marine Engineering Looe Ltd takes the privacy of your information very seriously. This privacy policy applies to our use of any and all Data collected by us or provided by you in relation to your use of the Website. **Please read this privacy policy carefully.**

## Definitions and interpretation

1. In this privacy policy, the following definitions are used:

<b>Data</b>	collectively all information that you submit to Marine Engineering Looe Ltd via the Website. This definition incorporates, where applicable, definitions provided in the Data Protection Act 1998;
<b>Cookies</b>	a small text file placed on your computer by this Website when you visit certain parts of the Website and/or when you use certain features of the Website. Details of the Cookies used by this Website are set out in the clause below ( <b>Cookies</b> );
<b>Marine Engineering Looe Ltd, we or us</b>	Marine Engineering Looe Ltd, a company incorporated in England and Wales with registered number <b>08570377</b> whose registered office is at C/O Mark Holt & Co Limited, 7 Sandy Court Ashleigh Way, Devon, PL7 5JX;
<b>UK and EU Cookie Law</b>	the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003 as amended by the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) (Amendment) Regulations 2011;
<b>User or you</b>	any third party that accesses the Website and is not either (i) employed by Marine Engineering Looe Ltd and acting in the course of their employment or (ii) engaged as a consultant or otherwise providing services to Marine Engineering Looe Ltd and accessing the website in connection with the provision of such services; and
<b>Website</b>	the website that you are currently using, <a href="http://www.marine-engineering-looe.co.uk">www.marine-engineering-looe.co.uk</a> , and any sub-domains of this site unless expressly excluded by their own terms and conditions.

2. In this privacy policy, unless the context requires a different interpretation:
  - a. the singular included the plural and vice versa;
  - b. references to sub-clauses, clauses, schedules or appendices are to sub-clauses, clauses, schedules or appendices of this privacy policy;
  - c. a reference to a person includes firms, companies, government entities, trusts and partnerships;
  - d. "including" is understood to mean "including without limitation";
  - e. reference to any statutory provision includes any modification or amendments of it;
  - f. the headings and sub-headings do not form part of this privacy policy.

## Scope of this privacy policy

3. This privacy policy applies only to the actions of Marine Engineering Looe Ltd and Users with respect to this Website. It does not extend to any websites that can be accessed from this website including, but not limited to, any links we may provide to social media websites.

## Data collected

4. We may collect the following Data, which includes personal Data, from you:
  - a. Demographic information such as post code, preferences and interests;
  - b. IP address (automatically collected);
  - c. Web browser type and version (automatically collected);
  - d. Operating system (automatically collected);

In each case in accordance with this privacy policy.

## Our use of data

5. For purpose of this Data Protection Act 1998, Marine Engineering Looe Ltd is the "data controller".
6. We will retain any data you submit for 1 month.

7. Unless we are obliged or permitted by law to do so, and subject to any third party disclosures specifically set out in this policy, your data will not be disclosed to third parties. This does not include our affiliates and / or other companies within our group.
8. All personal data is stored securely in accordance with the principles for the Data Protection Act 1998. For more details on security see the clause below (**Security**).
9. Any or all of the above Data may be required by us from time to time in order to provide you with the best possible service and experience when using our website.

Specifically, Data may be used by us for the following reasons:

- a. internal record keeping;

In each case, in accordance with this privacy policy.

### **Third party website and services**

10. Marine Engineering Looe Ltd may, from time to time, employ the services of other parties for dealing with certain processes necessary for the operation of the website. The providers of such services do not have access to certain personal data provided by users of this website.

### **Links to other websites**

11. This website may, from time to time, provide links to other websites. We have no control over such websites and are not responsible for the content of these websites. This privacy policy does not extend to your use of such websites. You are advised to read the privacy policy or statement of other websites prior to using them.

### **Social Media Policy & Usage**

12. We adopt a Social Media Policy to ensure our business and our staff conduct themselves accordingly online. 17. Wherever you are required to submit Data, you will be given options to restrict our use of that Data. This may include the following:
  18. Use of Data for direct marketing purposes; and
  19. Sharing Data with third parties.

### **Functionality of the Website**

20. To use all features and functions available on the Website, you may be required to submit certain Data.

### **Accessing your own data**

27. All Cookies used by this Website are used in accordance with current UK and EU Cookie law.
28. Before the Website places Cookies on your computer, you will be presented with a pop-up requesting your consent to set those Cookies. By giving your consent to the placing of Cookies, you are enabling Marine Engineering Looe Ltd to provide a better experience and service to you. You may, if you wish, deny consent to the placing of Cookies; however certain features of the website may not function fully or as intended.
29. This website may place the following Cookies:

Type of Cookie	Purpose
Analytical/performance cookies	they allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.

## General

33. You may not transfer any of your rights under this privacy policy to any other person. We may transfer our rights under this privacy policy where we reasonably believe your rights will not be affected.
34. If any court or competent authority finds that any provision of this privacy policy (or part of any provision) is invalid, illegal or unenforceable, that provision or part-provision will, to the extent required, be deemed to be deleted, and the validity and enforceability of the other provisions of this privacy policy will not be affected.
35. Unless otherwise agreed, no delay, act or omission by a party in exercising any right or remedy will be deemed a waiver of that, or any other, right or remedy.
36. This agreement will be governed by and interpreted according to the law of England and Wales. All disputes arising under the Agreement will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English and Welsh courts.

37. Marine Engineering Looe Ltd reserves the right to change this privacy policy as we may deem necessary from time to time or as may be required by law.
